Lesson Title: Nature Art with Andy Goldsworthy
All Ages and Adults

Objective:

Create a design using repetition and natural materials similar to artist Andy Goldsworthy. Some possibilities are: Spirals, Symmetrical Designs, Hearts, Square Spirals, Patterns, etc.

Don't forget to take a photograph of your art. Since your art is temporal (meaning it won't last) the photograph becomes the art.

Outside: Sticks, Rocks, Dirt, Flowers, Leaves, Sand, Stones,
Inside: Lettuce, Fruits and Vegetables, Shells, Rocks,
